Parts:

Arkansas: Price on boneless/skinless breast is lower; wings are steady to firm and other parts are steady. Trade volumes are light to very light as current commitments are adequate for trade needs. Offerings of wings are very light; boneless/skinless breasts are moderate to at times heavy and all other parts are light to moderate. Leg quarter export trade remained light to moderate. Boneless/skinless breasts \$1.41-\$1.67; leg quarters (bulk) 25-33¢, majority 30-32¢; and leg quarters (4/10) 36-37¢. Tenderloins, breast with ribs, front halves, legs, wings, drumsticks and thighs were too few to report.

Georgia: The f.o.b. dock quoted prices on ice-pack parts based on truckload and pool truckload lots for the week of Jul. 22: line run tenders \$2.10; skinless/boneless breasts \$1.90½; whole breasts \$1.07; boneless/skinless thigh meat 90½¢; thighs 48½¢; drumsticks 65¢; leg quarters 39½¢; wings \$1.22.
